5th Grade Spanish Enrichment (Dual Language)

- Students will practice writing complete sentences in Spanish.
- This week, we will continue testing for reading levels in Spanish (F&P and DRA).
- Students will need to read 20 minutes in Spanish twice a week.
- If your child does not have Spanish books at home, they may borrow one or two for the week from our library or visit a Chicago Public Library.
- Students will need to finish for homework the work they didn't finish in class.

6th Grade Spanish Language Arts (Dual Language)

- Students are reading a “just right book” of their choice.
- Students will have reading homework from Monday to Friday. Students need to read Spanish books for 20 minutes. Students are expected to make annotations and respond to their reading.
- If your child does not have Spanish books at home, they may borrow one or two for the week from our library or visit a Chicago Public Library.
- Students will need to finish for homework the work they didn't finish in class.

5th Grade Spanish as a Second Language (Gen Ed)

- Students are working on following class expectations.
- Students will be learning about family Spanish.
- This week, we will continue testing for oracy in Spanish assessment (Santillana).
- Students will have homework worksheets twice a week.
- Students will need to finish for homework the work they didn't finish in class.

6th Grade Spanish as a Second Language (Gen Ed)

- Students are working on spelling and pronouncing Spanish words.
- Students will study greetings and introductions in Spanish.
- Students will continue working on how to ask questions in Spanish.
- Students will have a vocabulary quiz every Friday.
- Students will need to finish for homework the work they didn't finish in class.
