<p>We are following the advanced, rigorous curriculum of Engage NY. The students will have a quiz on Module 1, Topic B on Wednesday 10/17. They will find missing values in the tables and plot the pairs of values on the coordinate plane. They will also use tables to compare different ratios to solve a problem.</p>	<p>In Earth Science we started the year by taking a brief tour of the biosphere, focusing on the amazing abilities of producers. Now we will begin our unit on the Hydrosphere. To introduce the unit we will be talking about the ocean and the importance of plankton in food chains and in the creation of oxygen in our atmosphere. We will then design plankton in class using everyday materials and test our plankton designs for neutral buoyancy in water against other classmates.</p>
